## ORDINANCE NO. 5 , SERIES 2023 AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING AN OPERATING BUDGET AND ALLOCATING FUNDS FOR JULY 1, 2023 THROUGH JUNE 30, 2024

WHEREAS, pursuant to provisions of the Kentucky Revised Statutes, and in the interest of sound fiscal planning, the City of Douglass Hills is empowered to adopt an operating budget;
