ORDINANCE NO. , SERIES 2022 AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING AN OPERATING BUDGET AND ALLOCATING FUNDS FOR JULY 1, 2022 THROUGH JUNE 30, 2023

WHEREAS, pursuant to provisions of the Kentucky Revised Statutes, and in the interest of sound fiscal planning, the City of Douglass Hills is empowered to adopt an operating budget;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DOUGLASS HILLS, KENTUCKY:

Section 1: That the annual budget for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2022, and ending June 30, 2023 is hereby adopted as follows:

<u>Section 3</u>: Any city expenditure approved by the City Council that results in a department exceeding the budgeted amount will be taken from the City's "Contingency".

Section 4: This ordinance shall take effect on July 1, 2022 and after publication as required by law.
