CITY OF DOUGLASS HILLS ORDINANCE #5, SERIES 2021

AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO FIXING THE COMPENSATION OF ELECTED OFFICIALS OF THE CITY OF DOUGLASS HILLS

WHEREAS, the City Council is aware City's Ordinance Section 20.004 states that the City Council shall establish the compensation of every elected city officer and Kentucky Revised Statutes 83A.75 also requires that compensation for elected representatives be set by ordinance,

AND WHEREAS, the City Council is aware that KRS 83A.070 requires that the pay of elected representatives must be set prior to the first Monday in May in the year that the officer is elected,

AND WHEREAS, the City council has reviewed the records of the City relating to pay for elected officials and finds that the compensation of the City Mayor should be raised to an amount more appropriate to the size of the City of Douglass Hills and the responsibilities of the office,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL:

Section 1. The compensation of the Mayor is hereby fixed at the sum of \$ 3,750 per month, or \$45,000 per year, commencing with the beginning of the Mayor's new term, January 2023.

Section 2. The amount of compensation for each of the elected officials shall be recomputed annually under the "rubber dollar" theory as referenced in KRS 83A.075 and shall be adjusted based on the "rubber dollar" increase amount as determined by the Commonwealth of Kentucky Department of Local Government (or its successor entity).

Section 3. Any ordinance, or section of an ordinance, in conflict with the foregoing sections is hereby repealed and replaced.
